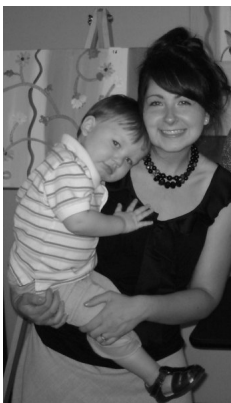


This Month's Featured Artist

View the fascinating art and meet the artists in each participating business. Additional businesses and restaurants will be open and ready to welcome you to our slice of artistic heaven.

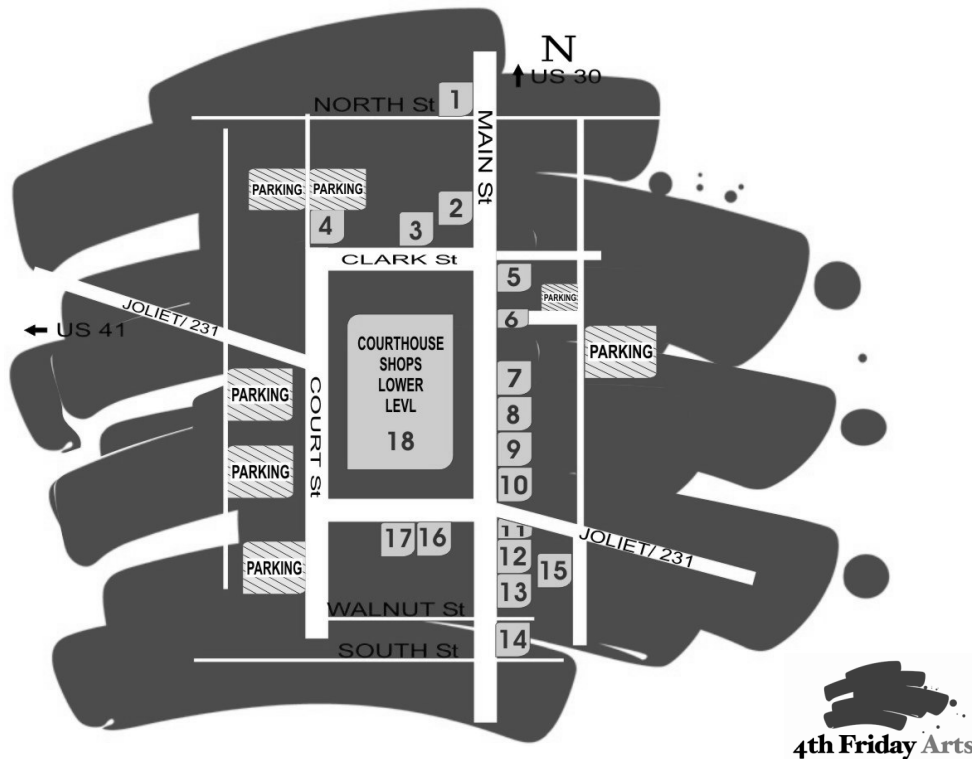
